

# Patient sprays once into each nostril



Step 4

# Instruct the patient to:

- Insert tip straight into the first nostril.
- Nose rest should touch the skin between the nostrils.



Instruct the patient to:

- Close opposite nostril.
- Breathe in through nose while pushing plunger all the way up until it stops.



Instruct the patient to:

• **Sniff gently** after spraying to keep medication inside nose.



Instruct the patient to:

- Switch hands to insert tip into the second nostril.
- Repeat Step 4 to deliver second spray.



# Instruct the patient to:

• Take device from patient.

 Check that indicator shows **no green dots.** If you see a green dot, have patient spray again into the second nostril.

 Check indicator again to confirm device is empty.



# Healthcare professional:

 Do not prime device. This will result in a loss of medication.

 Check that indicator shows 2 green dots. If not, dispose of device and get a new one. • Hand device to patient.

## **Confirm delivery and rest** Step 5



- Rest in a comfortable position (preferably, semi-reclined) for
- If liquid drips out, dab nose with a tissue.

**Do not** blow nose.

# Instruct the patient to:

- Hold device as shown with the thumb gently supporting the plunger.
- Do not press the plunger.



# Instruct the patient to:

 Recline head at about 45 degrees during administration to keep medication inside the nose.

# 5 MIN REST

5 minutes after each device.

# **Next device**



# Healthcare professional:

• Repeat Steps 2-5 for the next device.

**IMPORTANT:** Ensure that patient waits **5 minutes** after each device to allow medication to absorb.
